
## A Report on International Conference on "Current and Future Perspectives of Pharmaceuticals in Health Care" (CFPPHC-2023)









The conference started with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Mr. Khursheed A Sheikh, Research Scholar.

The conference started with a welcome address from Prof. (Dr.) R. K. Khar. He discussed the importance of the Conference to the audience and participants and wished them good luck for their future.




