The inaugural session was ended by the National Anthem and followed by high tea.



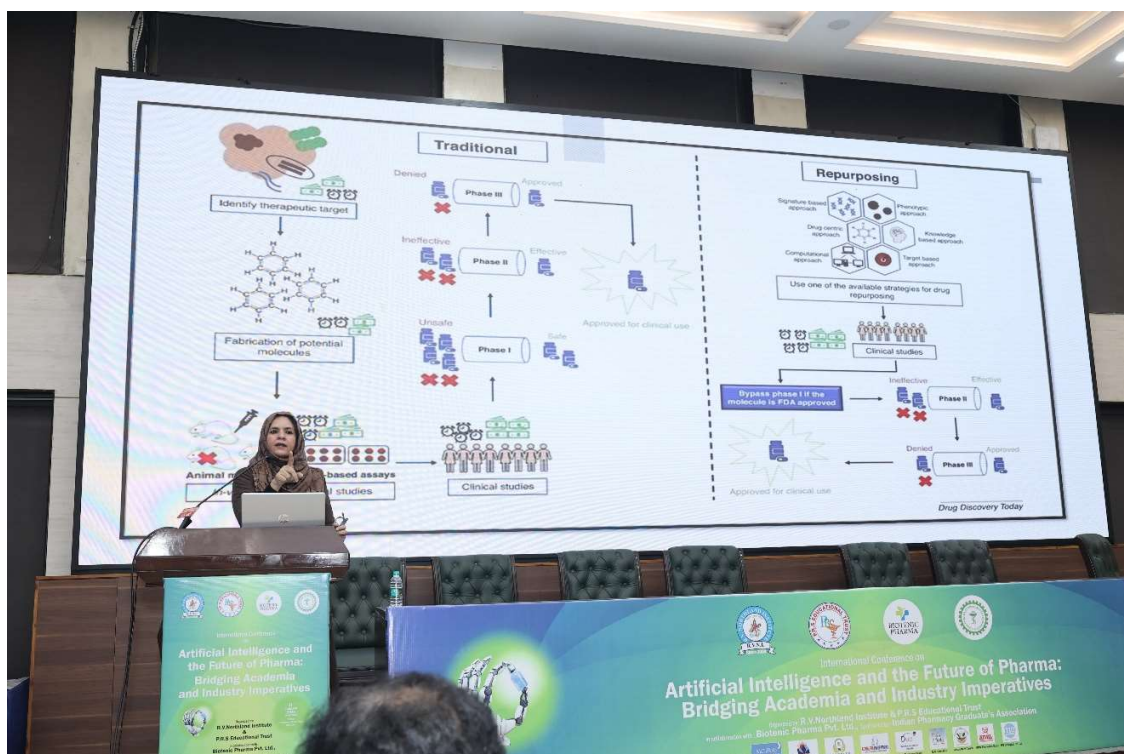
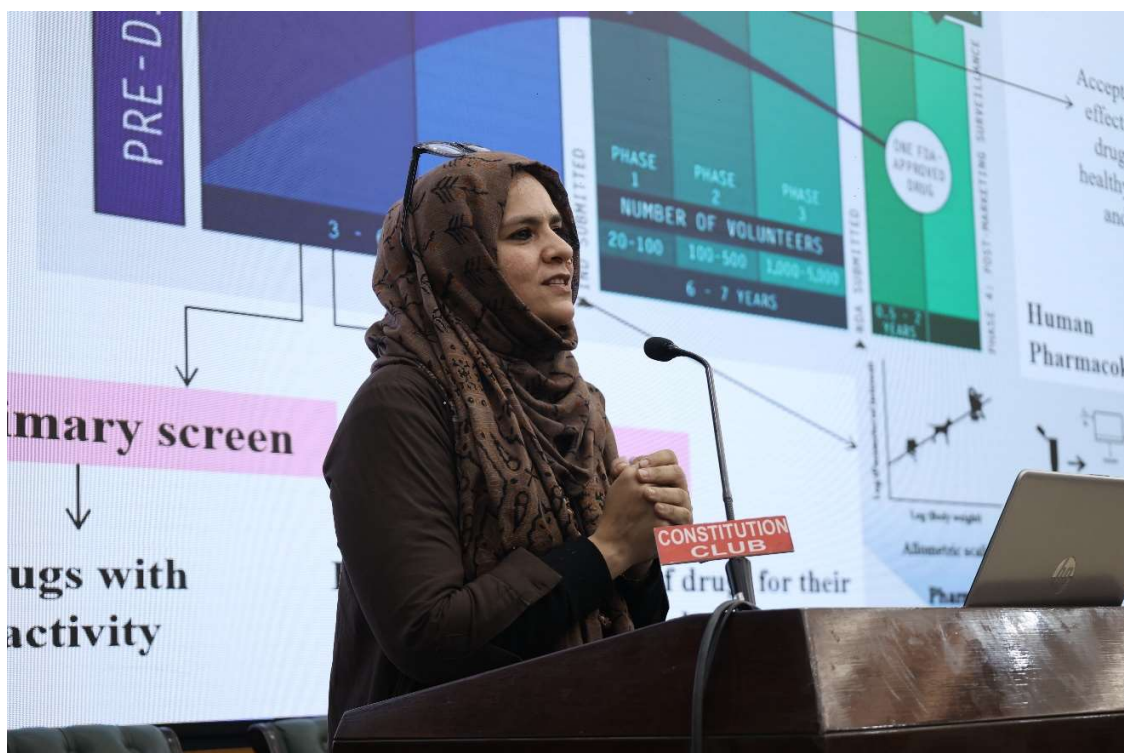
